**Re: Motion recommending Coastal Development permit approvals for slope repair at 2105 W. Paseo del Mar.**

Dear Representatives:

The following resolution was passed at the January 19, 2021 Coastal San Pedro Neighborhood Council Board and Stakeholder meeting:

### ***Coastline and Parks Committee motion***

***Whereas, a galvanized steel pipe that services the restrooms at Royal Palms Beach broke in 2016 on the property at 2105 W. Paseo del Mar, and  
Whereas, there has been a great deal of erosion as a result of this breakage, and  
Whereas, the Los Angeles County Department of Beaches and Harbors has accepted responsibility and are paying for the permitting and repairs, and  
Whereas, Royal Palms Beach is a hugely popular visitor serving destination, and  
Whereas, without the surficial slope repair, there is a serious risk of injury due to falling debris,***

***Resolved, Coastal San Pedro Neighborhood Council recommends that the City and the California Coastal Commission approve Coastal Development Permits requested by the Los Angeles County Department of Beaches and Harbors for the slope repair requested at 2105 W. Paseo del Mar.***
