Re: Request for increase in Public Access Electric Vehicle Stations

Dear Representatives:

At the November 20, 2017 meeting of the Coastal San Pedro Neighborhood Council, the board passed the following motion:

Whereas, there is a need for more Electric Vehicle Supply Equipment (EVSE) to provide power for Electric Vehicles in and around the Port of Los Angeles; and

Whereas, the Port of LA is working with San Pedro officials to build a destination resort and marketplace along the waterfront, and the Port of LA is uniquely positioned with current and developing parking areas, as well as the resources to install EVSEs; and

Whereas, the Port of LA, as a major source of air pollution, has an obligation to reduce pollution from vehicle and visitor traffic.

Therefore be it Resolved, that the Coastal San Pedro Neighborhood Council calls on Mayor Garcetti, Councilman Buscaino and the Port of LA Harbor Commission to immediately install public access EVSEs throughout its parking lots and other facilities.

Be it Further Resolved, that the Port of LA shall make public by January 1, 2018, the plans for installation of EVSEs on its properties in San Pedro and Wilmington.
